SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Alwoodley Motor Club will promote a National B Permit Autotest on Sunday 24th July 2011 at Sherburn Proving Ground, east of Leeds. The event is a round of the 2011 **Link-Up Ltd MSA** British Autotest Championship, the 2011 **demon tweeks Direct** BTRDA® Autotest Championship, the BTRDA® Allrounders Championship 2011 (supported by **REIS Insurance**), the 2011 **710 Oils Fuchs Titan Race** Association of Northern Car Clubs Autotest Championship 2011 and the Association of North Western Car Clubs Championship 2011.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd., (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the Club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit number 65164 has been granted.
4. The event is open to: -
 - (a) all fully elected members of the organising club.
 - (b) members of member clubs of the Association of Northern Car Clubs (ANCC).
 - (c) registered entrants of the 2011 **Link-Up Limited** MSA Autotest Championship (Championship Permit Number 2011/A/0700).
 - (d) registered entrants of the 2011 **demon tweeks Direct** BTRDA® Autotest Championship.
 - (e) registered entrants in the BTRDA® Allrounders Championship 2011, supported by **REIS Insurance** (MSA Reg Number 59/2011).
 - (f) registered entrants in the 2011 **710 Oils Fuchs Titan Race oil** ANCC Autotest Championship. (MSA Reg. Number 53/2011).
 - (g) registered entrants in the ANWCC Autotest Championship 2011 (MSA Reg. Number 28/2011).
5. All competitors must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card and/or a championship registration card.
6. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:-
 - 08.30 Scrutineering and Documentation starts
 - 10.00 PROMPT - Drivers briefing - at the site where you undertook documentation**
 - 10.15 First test starts
 - A short break of half an hour will be made for lunch at approximately 12.30hrs
 - 15.30 Planned finishing time of the last competitor.

Any competitor not signed on by 09.45 am may be excluded.
7. The event will consist of five classes as follows:-

Class A	Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length.
Class B	All other Saloon Cars.
Class C	Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
Class D	Specials
Class E	Road going Saloon Cars

Saloons will include estate cars, hatchbacks and commercial types as appropriate as well as saloon type Kit Cars. Cabriolets will run in the appropriate saloon car class or sports car class with hood down. All lengths refer to the overall length, which will be determined by the Parkers Car Price Guide (January 2011 edition) for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification. Sports Kit Cars eligible for class C will be as per the approved BTRDA® Championship list which is available from Helen Perren, Conifers, Cross Butts, Eccleshall, Staffs, ST21 6AX.

Class E Road going Saloon Cars. All vehicles in this class will be capable of being driven on the road, be taxed and have a current MoT test certificate (if applicable), which will be checked at signing-on.

All vehicles must comply with the relevant MSA tyre and vehicle regulations.
8. Awards will be presented as follows:-
 - (a) Fastest time of the day.
 - (b) Fastest time in each class.
 - (c) Second fastest time in each class (subject to 4 starters in that class)
 - (d) Third fastest time in each class (subject to 8 starters in that class)
 - (e) Best Alwoodley Club Member (subject to 3 starters)
 - (f) First Lady competitor (subject to 3 starters)

In the event of a tie, furthest fastest will apply.

Any award not picked up on the day of the event will be forfeit.

9. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes officially on the 21st July 2011. The entry fee is £27.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Email entries will be accepted so long as the entry fee is deposited in Alwoodley Motor Club's current account before the closing date for entries. Details of where to pay the fee is on the enclosed Entry form.

11. (a) The maximum entry for the meeting (including reserves) is 50.
(b) The minimum entry for the meeting is 20.
(c) Minimum for each class is 3.
(d) Should any of the minimum figures above not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.
(e) Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis.
(f) Entry fees will be refunded in the event of a withdrawal notified to the Secretary of the Meeting by noon on the 21st July 2011.

13. Provisional results will be displayed immediately after the event. Awards will be presented at the Signing-On/Results caravan (or the local cricket pavilion) as soon as possible after the results are made final.
14. Any protests must be made in accordance with **C 5.1 – 5.7**
15. (a) Details of tests will be provided with the final instructions. Please allow plenty of time to walk the tests before the start of competition. It is proposed that 3 test sites will be provided, competitors should attempt them in alphabetical or numerical order but each series of 3 must be completed before moving onto the next series. Timecards will be provided for one series at once; it is the competitor's responsibility to hand in each completed card. The results team will issue the next time card on receipt of a completed card.
(b) Each driver will have a minimum of six runs at each test site, all times to count in the results.
(c) Timing will be by hand held digital stopwatch to 1/10th sec.
(d) When the marshal indicates the course is open, please place your front offside wheel between the start lines. You may then start in your own time (the starting signal will be "in your own time"). Timing starts as your off side front wheel crosses the second line, and stops as your leading wheel crosses the stop line to stop astride the line. On all tests a 5 second penalty will be imposed for crossing the finish line with more than two wheels or hitting any cones.
16. Practicing will not be allowed. Strictly out of bounds is the main runway area - **M 3.5**
17. Competitors will be identified by numbers, supplied by the organisers.
18. Marking and penalties will be as printed in section **M 9.4 Table M7** except the following which is modified
(d) 5 marks lost
19. All other General Regulations of the MSA will apply except for the following which are amended:
M 4.2 - some pylons may be less than 1m in height. There may be cones (coloured green) of not more than 0.5M in height that will be situated on tests. These are designed to help guide competitors to take the correct route. Hitting one or more of these cones will not pick up any penalties.
M 7.8 deleted, The definition of test performance and wrong test is as follows:-
'In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only, whilst a sequence of manoeuvres will be mandatory but not exclusive. A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realises his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram.'
M 13.3 & M 13.4 – A vehicle may be entered twice by two different drivers.
M 17.1 - Vehicles (other than those in Class E – see SR7) need not be licensed since the whole event will take place on private property.
D17.1 & D 17.1.1 – Two competitors may share the same vehicle but no one can drive more than one vehicle.

20. Please make sure that your car is properly silenced to comply with **J 5.17.1 – J 5.17.8 & J 5.18.1 – J 5.18.11 (Chart 5.18)**. Noise checks will be carried out during the course of the competition. Noisy cars are not welcome at **Sherburn Proving Ground** and you will be refused a start if you fail the noise test.
21. Please note the Tyre requirement of **J 5.9.1 – J 5.9.5** (1.6mm tread). **No MSA list 1b tyres are permitted (Blue book pages 194 and 196)**.
22. A reminder, to comply with **M 16.7.1** a small 'spill kit' must be carried by the competing car and it must comply with **J 5.20.13**. There will be no kits available on the day to purchase from the organisers.
23. (a) Competitors are asked to do their utmost to present themselves for scrutineering as soon after 08.30 so that the event can start promptly, and that as many tests as possible can be completed.
(b) Please leave the site litter free, a black plastic bag will be provided to each competitor for rubbish; please take these bags home with you.
(c) The Sherburn Proving Ground is situated approximately 1 mile east of Sherburn in Elmet village. The entrance is off the B1222 at map reference: 105 /525336½). After leaving the B1222 please follow the arrows to the Autotest site. A map of the area will be provided with the final instructions.
(d) There are no established facilities on site; however, portable toilet facilities will be available.
(e) Club officials can be contacted on the day on **07748 622365**
(f) Refreshments will be on sale during the day, including Hot Bacon Rolls plus tea or coffee and chocolate biscuits etc.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO THE 2011 INTER ASSOCIATION TEAM EVENT

A. Alwoodley Motor Club will organise a National 'B' Autotest on Sunday 24 July 2011 on behalf of the Association of Northern Car Clubs. The event will be an invitation Inter Association Team event.

B. The supplementary regulations numbers 1 : 23 (above) apply to the Inter Association Team event unless varied by the Supplementary regulations numbered A : H.

C. The event is open to members of three car teams representing the Regional Associations of the MSA, and nominated reserves for the teams. In addition entries are encouraged from female competitors to compete for a separate award. Any number of teams per Association will be accepted. All those taking part in the Inter Association Team event must have individually entered the Fern Furnishing Autotest.

D. The teams will consist of any three cars, one of which must be from Class B or E, from the classes listed in SR7. Each Association may enter any number of teams plus one reserve from each class. Each team must include a class B or class E car and two other from different classes, i.e. Team of three cars from A, B and C, or A, D and E or B, C and D. Teams must be confirmed before the start of the event.

The classes are as defined in SR7 save for Class E which is amended as follows:

Class E – Road going saloon cars **over 11ft overall length**

If any team is a member short, the Association of Northern Car Clubs will *attempt* to provide a third member or a reserve as required.

E. Awards will be presented as follows:-

1 Inter Association Challenge Shield	- Best Team
2 An Award	- Next Best Team
3 An Award	- Next Best Team
4 An Award	- Fastest Individual Time of the Day in the Inter Association Team event
5 An Award	- Best Ladies Team (Subject to two ladies teams)

Additional awards/replicas may be presented at the discretion of the organisers

F. Reserves.

Each Association may enter one reserve driver per class. These must be nominated on an official entry form. Reserves will run in class order and in team running order before the teams begin each test. Reserve drivers may only be brought into teams after the Team Captain has the permission of the Clerk of the Course. An Association entering more than one team and not having a nominated reserve to replace a retiring driver will have the option of retiring one of its teams to create the necessary reserve(s). When a team is forced to retire, the members of that team that are still capable of competing may do so and will be eligible for the Fastest Time of the Day award.

G. Mechanical Breakdown.

In the event of a team member suffering a mechanical breakdown he/she will have two options:

- 1 - Incurring a maximum for that test.
- 2 - Substituting the reserve's time for the test. The reserve will then be considered to be a team member for the rest of the competition.
